Corporate Athlete

Economic Times recently reported some shocking and distorting facts and figures pertaining to survey of 2 lakh employees across India of which major highlights were: 46% of workforce in organizations in India suffers from some or the other form of stress. 43% have skewed BMI (Body Mass Index) and 30% have diabetic risk.

The growth in the corporate atmosphere requires increased inputs pertaining to time, energy, mental modeling and integrated understanding. During the journey, one of the prominent aspect which is ignored is Health.



As a Youth, one might be able to drag and dip into work for long hours without actually caring about the physical damage being created in a long run. Working for late hours in challenging roles requires mental and physical endurance. Also, the energy requirement and nutrition combination our body needs have straight correlation with the age.

The Athletes on the track and field have to go through rigorous training to work on stamina, performance improvement and above all ensuring injury free season. The difference between a corporate sprinter and the real one is the amount of time for preparation of performance and the recovery period post performance. The Athlete would deal in season by season which accommodates rest as an important part of training and load of workout in pre and post season is comparatively low. In the same regards, the corporate athlete doesn't have the luxury of such rest period post an important deal completion neither any health related refreshment after a tough month or guarter.

Managers are a typical dual performer on the field i.e. Sprinter and Marathoners as they have to carry a journey of 30-40 years along with adrenaline performance on a daily basis consisting of stress and fatigue related to long-hours at workplace, meetings, travel time and any other assignment which they have stumbled upon due to initiative skills or have been entrusted due to the faith of management.

Focusing on health and wellbeing would call for a fine balance between physical fitness, endurance, resilience taking care of stress, sleep and diet. Adequate level of water intake and stabilizing sleep schedule is a good way to start with. Conscious efforts to take care of the diet leads to better energy management. Adding a religious routine for normal workout like walking, swimming, outdoor sports activities, yoga would help your mind to focus on other than the world of work leading to reduced burnout and improve productivity. Organizational Policy consisting of balanced health and wellness can lower staff absenteeism and boost morale.


